The Saint-Tropez Skinny Scarf, part of my Riviera Collection, is a beautiful blue and white accessory with lots of versatility. Inspired by gently cresting waves of the blue Mediterranean Sea, when worn as a hair ribbon it invokes a vintage feel of a 1950s sunbathing Grace Kelly. This skinny scarf works not only as a hair accessory but can be worn as a neckerchief or attached to a bag. It's an easy way to add a little chic to any look. ## MATERIALS

- 1 skein Friends Cotton 8/4 by Hobbii in White (01) - Color A  
(super fine, weight 1; 174yds/160m per skein)
- 1 skein Friends Cotton 8/4 by Hobbii in Midnight Blue (87) - Color B  
(super fine, weight 1; 174yds/160m per skein)
- Size US E/4 (3.5mm) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

Gauge is not important unless the weight of the yarn or size of crochet hook are changed.

## FINISHED DIMENSIONS

51 in (130cm) x 3 in (8cm)

## ABBREVIATIONS

All Cathedrals & Cafes patterns are written in standard US terms.

<b>Ch</b>	Chain
<b>Ch-sp</b>	Chain space
<b>Dc</b>	Double crochet
<b>P</b>	Picot stitch
<b>Sc</b>	Single crochet
<b>Sl st</b>	Slip stitch
<b>St(s)</b>	Stitch/Stitches

## STITCH EXPLANATION FOR V-STITCH AND PICOT STITCH

For V-stitch: A V-stich is (dc, ch 1, dc) all in the same stitch or ch-sp.

For Picot Stitch: Sc 1, ch 3, sc into back bump of first ch in the ch 3.

## NOTES

Main color body of scarf is crocheted first. Picot trim in contrasting color is added last.

## PATTERN

With Color A, Ch 16.

Row 1 In 5th ch from hook, make a V-stitch (dc, ch 1, dc). Sk 2 ch, make V-stitch. Repeat until last 2 ch. Sk 1 ch, dc in last ch. Chain 3, turn.

Row 2 Sk 1st st. Make 1 V-stitch into each ch-1 space across row. Dc in top of turning chain. Chain 3, turn.

Row 3-93 Repeat row 2.

Fasten off.

With Color B, join yarn at top right corner of long side.

(Ch 1, sc 1, p 1, sc 1) in turning ch-sp.

\*Sc 1, p 1, sc 1 in next ch-sp. Repeat from \* across length of hair ribbon. Crochet 1 picot at each corner as you work around the ribbon.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.



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
